- (ii) The details of the Online transaction no. Viz. Amount paid/ Transaction ID/ Transaction date invariably be mentioned in the Online application.

D. SELECTION PROCEDURE:

- (i) All eligible candidates should apply in the application format **appended below**. Applications received after the last date of receipt of applications will not be considered.
- (ii) It has been decided to shortlist the candidates for the post of Assistant Professor on the basis of eligibility criteria notified by Medical Council of India (MCI) vide its notification No. MCI-12(1)/2017-MED.MISC./115698 dated 5TH JUNE 2017 published in the Gazette on 8TH JUNE, 2017.

E. How to Apply: -

- (i) Candidates must apply online through URL: http://central.esicmchsnr.co.in/applicationform1.aspx. No other means/mode of application will be accepted. Applications received through any other mode will not be accepted and will be summarily rejected.
- (ii) After submitting the online application, the candidates are required to take print out of the finally submitted online application and retain the same with them.
- (iii) Candidates are not required to submit to ESIC either by post or by hand the printouts of their online applications or any other document.
- (iv) A candidate should submit only one application for a particular specialty or post in a particular institution.
